Quick UTD Facts

- In 2016, the University was assigned the [highest classification of research activity](#) by the Carnegie Commission on Higher Education. Historically denoted as an “R1 University,” the classification acknowledges UT Dallas as a doctoral-granting university with the highest research activity. UT Dallas is among 115 universities in the U.S. with this classification.
- UT Dallas ranks No. 1 in the United States and 21st in the world in the 2017 *Times Higher Education Young University Rankings* of the world’s most outstanding universities under 50 years old.

- The solution to one of the most famous mathematics problems, the Poincaré Conjecture, was first posted on Cornell's arXiv.org.
- Astronomer Carl Sagan spent most of his career as a professor at Cornell and was the director for the Laboratory of Planetary Studies.
- Bill Nye "the Science Guy" studied mechanical engineering at Cornell and received his bachelor's degree in 1977. Nye took an astronomy class taught by Sagan. He occasionally guest-lectures introductory level astronomy and human ecology classes at Cornell.
